STATEMENT: Illinois Latino Agenda Congratulates Dulce M. Quintero for Her New Role as Acting Secretary of IDHS, Celebrates Deputy Governor Sol Flores's Tenure

CHICAGO - The following is a statement from the <u>Illinois Latino Agenda (ILA)</u>, a coalition that advocates for the wellbeing of Latinos throughout Illinois and for representation of Latinos in all levels of government and in all sectors, in response to <u>Governor Pritzker's announcement</u> that Deputy Governor for Health and Human Services Sol Flores is departing from her role and Dulce M. Quintero has been named as Acting Secretary at Illinois Department of Health and Human Services (IDHS):

"The Illinois Latino Agenda applauds the work of Deputy Governor for Health and Human Services (HHS) Sol Flores, who led HHS through its COVID-19 pandemic response, oversaw the expansion of healthcare access, spearheaded interagency strategies to help the most vulnerable in Illinois, and helped manage the state's response to the migrant crisis. Her leadership serves as an example of how our government leaders can take an equitable and culturally competent approach to address the issues that impact our communities. We look forward to working with Grace Hou who will fill the Deputy Governor position and thank her for her work at IDHS.
